## Artificial Intelligence under the Sea

### Tests for an autonomous measurement network in Eckernförde Bay

20 October 2020/ Kiel. Starting today, the GEOMAR research vessel ALKOR operates in Eckernförde Bay to test an autonomous measurement network with a total of seven stations over a period of eleven days. During the expedition, the communication and cooperation of the various devices will be tested and it will also be investigated how the system reacts autonomously to environmental changes. The expedition is part of the Helmholtz project ARCHES in cooperation with the Alfred Wegener Institute, Helmholtz Centre for Polar and Marine Research (AWI) and the German Aerospace Centre (DLR).
