Cooperation between the captain and the scientific expedition leader – definition of responsibilities

I. General

The success of scientific expeditions depends on a trusting cooperation between the captain and the scientific expedition leader - further referred to as the expedition leader. Because of this, only the principles for definition of the relevant responsibilities can be specified in this agreement. In individual cases, more detailed descriptions, or any necessary deviations can be agreed by the parties to the contract.

In case of hindrance, the expedition leader is represented by his/her deputy. The expedition leader and his/her deputy are nominated by the client.

II. Powers and remits of the expedition leader and his/her deputy

- 1. The expedition leader is responsible for the performance of the scientific work.
- 2. The expedition communicates the daily plan for the scientific work to the captain in good time, so that each can fulfil their duties according to the ship chartering agreement.
- 3. The expedition leader is responsible equipping the ship 0 is respoib(12 (t

IV. Disputes

Disputes between the crew and the persons taken on board must be jointly resolved by the expedition leader and the captain.
